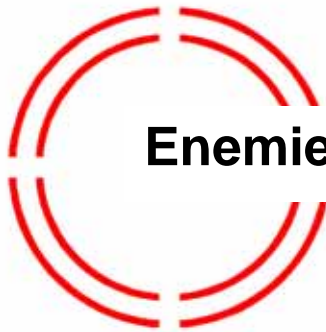




Forlorn Hope
