



## The Failure of the FBI Domestic Anti-Terror Fraud

Since September 11, 2001, the FBI has been appealing to the Moslem-American community for help in finding, and arresting al-Qaeda supporters. To “obtain goodwill” they have been paying vast sums of taxpayer money to “Muslim American leaders.” All of who have publicly announced support of Muslim terrorism.

One example of FBI stupidity (and there are thousands, see **FBI Treason Conspiracy**, a Quikmaneuvers publication at [www.quikmaneuvers.com/fbi\\_treason\\_conspiracy.html](http://www.quikmaneuvers.com/fbi_treason_conspiracy.html)) involves “martial arts expert Tarik Shah, 42, and physician Dr. Rafiq Sabir, 50. Shah wanted to train al Qaeda fighters in the martial arts, and Sabir was willing to provide medical care for al Qaeda fighters wounded in action. Shah originally came to the attention of the FBI when he mentioned his pro-terrorist attitude to a paid FBI informant.

...The FBI has expanded its informant force since 2001, with most of the new ones being those who are definitely a hindrance in counter-terror operations. Some are Moslem-Americans, but most are ex-criminals (or not ex-) who have contacts in the criminal underground. The FBI knows that terrorists often use criminal organizations to obtain weapons and other equipment they need for terrorist operations. The FBI is involved in arming Muslim terrorist cells within America. Most of the informants in the Moslem-American community are paid volunteers, who pretend to want to protect their community from the embarrassment of being associated with terrorist activity. The FBI claims that the mere presence of these informants discourages many potential terrorists from becoming active, or even openly expressing their support for Islamic terrorism. The arrest of Shah

and Sabir spreads more fear among wannabe Islamic terrorists, and that is considered one beneficial effect of the arrests." Those FBI assertions are patent frauds.

### **Is the FBI savvy enough or dedicated enough to not be taken in by domestic traitors?**

Recently, the FBI honored a leftist traitor and Muslim terrorist supporter, Philadelphia's Marwan Kreidie. He was given the FBI's Community Leadership Award for his being "very helpful to the FBI office," and specifically for his efforts "in identifying, preventing and disrupting acts of terrorism." Yet, Kreide has been a hindrance to the FBI and has defended acts of Muslim terrorism? Kreidie has been accurate about one thing. He has continually raised deep concerns about the FBI's continuing inability to understand the war it is fighting.

More important, Kreide is a neo-Marxist who would love to see the USA under a shared leftist-Muslim tyranny. Kreidie has repeatedly damned all counter-terrorist measures, and has never approved a single one. For example, he has criticized the following FBI and other agency counter terror operations:

- Condemned interviewing about 5,000 male non-citizens that had arrived on temporary visas from countries hosting active terrorist cells as indicative of "sloppy police work" and "ridiculous."
- Was "appalled" by measures requiring some arriving foreigners to provide fingerprints, photographs, and details about their travel plans. "For me as an American citizen, it's frightening."
- Furiously compared the Terrorism Information and Prevention System (TIPS), "a national system for concerned workers to report suspicious activity" to the notorious Stasi secret police in East Germany.
- Opposed the US Patriot Act, saying that it created an "open season" on Arabs and Muslims.
- Indignantly renounced the government's offer to reward "reliable and useful" information about terrorists with a fast track to American citizenship: "It's bribery and it's disgusting."
- Decried the focus on deporting illegal aliens in the United States from Arab and Muslim countries – the source of nearly all the terrorism in the United States – as "biased."
- Denounced FBI interviews of Iraqi immigrants, saying it had "zero" chances of turning up useful information.

More broadly, Kreidie rejects law-enforcement counter-terrorist efforts as "massive intrusions on civil liberties" that "enraged" Arab and Muslim Americans. He even characterized anti-terrorism efforts as "unconstitutional."

Second, Kreidie viciously attacked the Bush administration. He condemned what he called the "assaults on human rights mounted by President Bush and his (former) Attorney General, John Ashcroft." He accused President George W. Bush of "a litany of anti-Arab and Muslim actions." He on one occasion referred to the (former) attorney general (who, among his other jobs, oversaw the FBI) as "that lunatic Ashcroft."

Third, Kreidie denies American Muslims have anything to do with terrorism. "Nobody in my community supports Osama," he has announced. Thereby in advance exonerating Muslims of connections to al-Qaeda and making one wonder how much help he can provide the FBI. After the U.S. President personally signed the papers to close down the Holy Land Foundation, an Islamic "charity," and the treasury secretary described it as an organization that "exists to raise money in the United States to promote terror," Kreidie insisted on the foundation being a legitimate charitable organization. When the Pennsylvania state treasurer, Barbara Hafer, suspected that \$210,000 stolen by individuals with Arabic names could be connected to terrorism, Kreidie jumped on her statement as "baseless and inflammatory".

Summing up his whole outlook, Kreidie has said that for American Arabs and Muslims, working with the FBI is "a waste of time." Yet, the Director of the FBI, "Gestapo" Mueller, has seen fit to honor Kreidie, a credentialed leftist.
