HUMINT Today

Human intelligence (HUMINT) is the oldest of the intelligence disciplines, and has even been described as the second-oldest profession. Before the advent of photography and of communications technologies such as telegraphy and radio--which led to the other disciplines of imagery intelligence (IMINT) and signals intelligence (SIGINT)--HUMINT was the only intelligence discipline. Ironically, HUMINT was the most effective form of intelligence collection thousands of years ago and today it is still the most important form of intelligence collection. All technological forms of intelligence collection remain inferior to HUMINT.

Through the course of the twentieth century, beginning during and after the Second World War, the emphasis that the U.S. Army, US armed forces, the CIA and all other American agencies supposedly collecting information for America, discarded HUMINT.
